

Democracy:

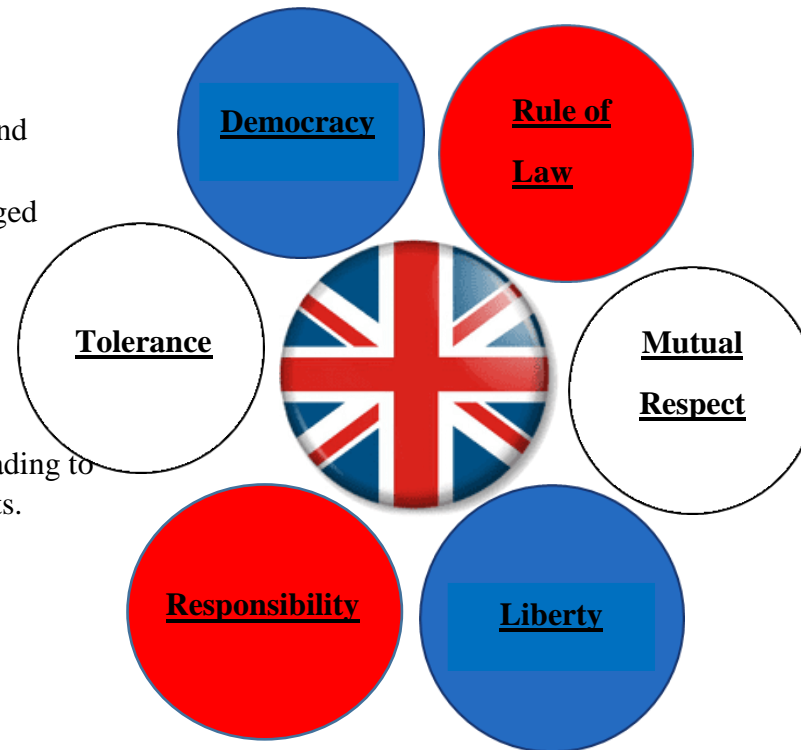
- Children are involved in the democratic process e.g. School council members as well as house captains and Sports Captains are democratically elected by peers, pupil voice is represented in deciding rewards and incentives etc
- School Council membership
- Democracy linked lessons and assemblies

Mutual Respect:

- PSHE / RSE curriculum
- Learning through whole school assemblies and curriculum topics.
- Positive relationships modelled and encouraged
- RE curriculum
- Anti-bullying policy
- E-safety education
- School Council
- Well-being Ambassadors
- Partnership Sports link with local schools leading to participation in competitions and tournaments.
- *Inter-house* events and competitions.

Tolerance:

- Stories from World faiths and cultures
- Annual International week
- Workshops e.g. Hindu dance, steel pan drums etc.
- RE curriculum – follows the Surrey agreed syllabus and includes the study of all major faiths
- Reflection opportunities in assemblies
- Visits to places of worship
- Assembly speakers from different religions and cultures e.g. Local Vicar, Muslim speaker.
- Equalities policy and Accessibility Plan
- Buddies / Well – Being Ambassadors promote resolution behaviours and tolerance
- Inclusive school where children with SEND are supported and nurtured by their peers.



Rule of Law:

- School Behaviour policy – children are involved in class and playground behavior charters
- Pupils have opportunities to reflect on the need for rules and laws e.g. during assemblies.
- Pupil questionnaires relating to behavior and safety.
- School visits – police, fire brigade, Internet safety and rules
- Home / school communication regarding behaviours.

Responsibility and Liberty:

- School and class rules
- School values
- Pupil's roles and responsibilities in school e.g. House captains, buddies, sports captains
- Well-being Ambassadors
- Visits from Fire Brigade, police, RNLI etc.
- Wide range of fundraising: Local (food banks), National (Children in Need) and Global (Comic Relief)
- Lessons on Healthy choices as part of PSHE / RSE / Science curriculum
- E-safety training
- Bikeability training
