Identify and represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations including the number line, and use the language of; equal to, more than, less than (fewer, most, least)	0-10 Sort, group, label, represent, count, objects, type, colour, size, forwards, backwards, more, less, compare, order, greater than, less than, equal to.
<b>Week 6&amp;7</b> Addition within 10	Represent and use numbers bonds to 10 Read, write and interpret mathematical statements involving addition (+) and equals (=) signs. Add one digit numbers to 10 including 0.
