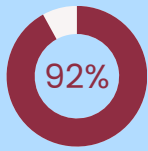


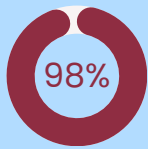
Parent Survey Results 2024

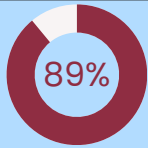
92%

of parents and carers say that their child is happy at St James.



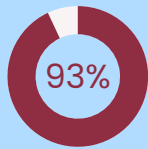
98%

of parents and carers feel that their child feels safe at school.



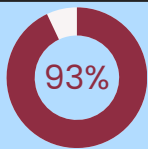
89%

of parents and carers say that their child does well at this school.



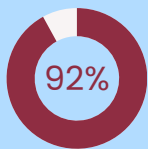
93%

of parents say that the school makes sure that the pupils are well-behaved.



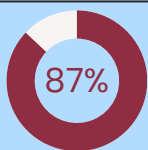
93%

of parents say that the school makes them aware of what their children are learning.



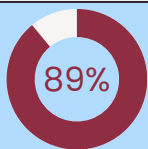
92%

of parent agree that the school has a strong safeguarding culture.



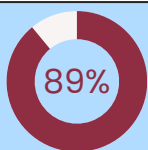
87%

Parent Survey Results 2024

Following our consultation with parents, please see below our next steps.

Action 1:

To reflect on the number of communications sent to parents and consider a better system to avoid overwhelming parents with too many emails.

Action 2

To continue to review the offer at Sunset and Sunrise to ensure we are offering the best provision to those who use this service, including striving to increase availability.

Action 3

To share processes and timelines for bullying allegations with parents so that the investigation process is clearly understood.

Action 4

To enhance communication about progress and attainment, and support that is being put in place, especially for those children with SEND or those who are not meeting national expectations.

Action 5

Continue to share information about School's Safeguarding duty with parents so there is a shared understanding for the reasons for our procedures and processes.

Action 6

Continue to support working parents/carers by issuing an overview of school dates so that parent/carers can make arrangements to attend key events.

Action 7

To provide information to parents about what stretch and challenge looks like at St James, and provide information about the mastery philosophy for maths.
